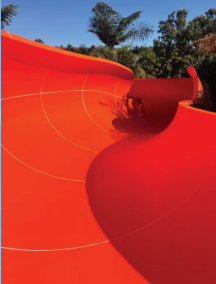

Gelcoat (Repair and Resurface)

Gelcoat is the protective and decorative coating found on the interior surface of waterslides. Proper maintenance is essential, but after 5–10 years of exposure to sun and use, wear and damage are common. Examples include spider cracks in the fiberglass, punctures from natural elements, surface scars, worn areas

exposing the fiberglass, and negatively aligned panels. Gelcoat resurfacing and recoating not only restore a smooth, safe, like-new ride experience but also protect the underlying fiberglass and enhance the visual appeal of your waterpark.



Exterior Coatings

Maintaining an aesthetically superior waterpark is a top priority. Guests often choose where to bring their families based on cleanliness, appearance, and overall maintenance. Applying exterior Siloxane coatings to your waterslides helps preserve a clean, glossy finish for years. Unlike many common coatings, Siloxane is a high-performance marine-grade product—not water-based—and offers excellent UV resistance. With proper surface preparation, it won't peel or degrade like other coatings currently used in the field.



Sandblasting

Sandblasting plays a vital role in many waterpark maintenance applications. Rusting structures can quickly become safety hazards and require immediate attention. While some may rely on power washing and painting when refinishing pools, we take pride in delivering top-quality work. That's why we always recommend proper surface preparation — including sandblasting the pool, crack chasing, and seam filling — to ensure lasting results and a safer environment.



Caulking

Caulking seams is a crucial part of waterslide maintenance. Leaks can lead to structural rust, water loss, and damage to surrounding landscaping. Over time, panels may shift closer together, and cracks in the fiberglass can develop, potentially creating unsafe riding conditions.

3 Stage Buffing

This isn't a simple 'wax on, wax off' job. Our three-stage buffing process includes high-grit sanding, liquid sandpaper cutting, and a UV polymer wax finish. Unlike quick fixes that look shiny for a couple of weeks and then fade or worsen, we sand down to a fresh layer of gelcoat, use liquid sandpaper to restore color, and apply a high-quality.



Inspections

In many states, third-party inspections are required to ensure the safety and compliance of waterparks.
